

Volunteer Information

Thank you for your service as a volunteer. We truly appreciate all who volunteer to help with our daily operations and ministry.

Who is a volunteer? A volunteer is a person who provides their time and service directly to an insured entity without remuneration or compensation.

In accordance with the Diocese of Cleveland's Policy for the Safety of Children in Matters of Sexual Abuse, any volunteer at an organization covered by this policy who works with children more than four (4) hours per month or who works with children more frequently than once a month must complete a screening process, Virtus training, and review and acknowledge the Diocesan Standards of Conduct for Ministry. This requirement helps to protect youth within the Diocese, as well as volunteers, and is intended to provide a safe environment for all in our Church.
